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Dear Sir

I arrived here yesterday from yesterday from Pucatan with a cargo of fruit on the schooner Dolphin chartered by ^{Mr} Millett and myself. I was very sick when I sailed from Pucatan, and had a very bad trip, and am still very weak. The General arrived all safe incognito. I never saw him back letter. I shall return from his in about four or five days & try to take some passengers, if you can send any that can pay part or all their fare, I will make arrangements for them. The General had gone to Villa and I did not see him when I started which will account for his ^{not} sending you any word by me. The British Government have landed 500 regular soldiers from Jamaica on the Island, for what purpose unknown.
