THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF NICARAGUA

To all who shall see these Presents, Greeting :

Know Ye, That reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity and abilities of
Captain Will Morris, Quartermaster.

I do hereby, by the authority in me vested, appoint him *Major Quartermaster*
in the service of the Republic of Nicaragua as such, from the *Twenty third* of *October*
1856. He is, therefore, carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of *Major Quartermaster*
by doing and performing all things thereto belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all officers and
soldiers under his command to be obedient to his orders as *Major Quartermaster*. And he is
to observe and follow such orders and directions, from time to time, as he shall receive from me or the future
President of the Republic of Nicaragua, or the General or other superior officers act over him, according to the
rules and discipline of War.

This commission is continue in force during the pleasure of the President of Nicaragua for the time being.

day of *January* in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and *fifty seven*.
