

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF NICARAGUA

To all who shall see these Presents, Greeting :

Know Ye, That reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity and abilities of
Captain Will Morris, Quartermaster.

I do hereby, by the authority in me vested, appoint him Major Quartermaster
in the service of the Republic of Nicaragua as such, from the twenty third of October
1856. He is, therefore, carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of Major Quartermaster
by doing and performing all things thereto belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all officers and
soldiers under his command to be obedient to his orders as Major Quartermaster. And he is
to observe and follow such orders and directions, from time to time, as he shall receive from me or the future
President of the Republic of Nicaragua, or the General or other superior officers set over him, according to the
rules and discipline of War.

This commission to continue in force during the pleasure of the President of Nicaragua for the time being.

Given under my hand, at the City of Rivas this Eleventh
day of January in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and fifty seven.
